ALL STAR TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

The BAA participates in Tournament Baseball and Softball during the months of June and July – after the regular season ends. While the recreational season is geared towards learning the game while having fun, All Star teams are more competitive-based where competing to win plays a larger role. All recreational season players aged 7-16 are welcome, but they will need to “try-out” for roster spots in early-June. If your child is selected to an All Star Team, pertinent information follows:

- “Tryouts” are usually held early-June on a Saturday and/or Sunday. BAA Coaches from all levels will evaluate player performance and combine the results with ratings developed by analysis of scorebooks from the regular season. The most qualified players will be offered roster spots. The BAA will send emails to parents in mid-May indicating “Tryout” dates.
- All Star Team practices will begin mid-June or sooner, but no later than the end of the regular season - or after playoffs for higher age levels.
- Each age level that can field a team will host a *Home Tournament* in Bridgeville and participate in an *Away Tournament* for a weekend (if all players are available).
- **The Parents/Guardians of each player selected to participate on an All Star Team will be required to submit a \$150 deposit in order to receive that player’s All Star uniform.** However, a full refund of the deposit will be given once all Parent/Guardian responsibilities listed below have been performed.
 - **Complete six (6) field-related work shifts during that player’s home tournament.** Work shifts can include; announcing a game, preparing the field before and after a game, selling 50/50 tickets, scorekeeping, operating the score board, and emptying trash containers. Upon completion of these shifts, \$100 of the deposit will be returned. Parents/Guardians will use the signupgenius.com website to select the desired shifts.
 - **Complete three (3) shifts at the concession stand during that player’s home tournament.** These shifts can include working behind the counter or cooking at the grill. Upon completion of these three shifts, \$50 of the deposit will be returned. Parents/Guardians will use the signupgenius.com website to select the desired shifts.
- **Other than the \$150 refundable deposit, all other expenses are paid by the BAA.** This includes, entrance fees for travel tournaments, trophies, and tournament team hats, shirts, and socks (if applicable).
- The tournament schedules will be provided with as much notice as possible; we ask that you make every effort to be available for the games. *This may require planning vacations for after the months of June and July.*

Please remember, the BAA is a non-profit, volunteer-based organization.
